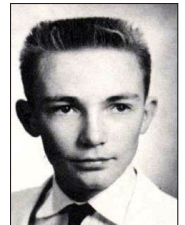


FROM TONI MACDONALD (STORY INVOLVES LAUNA WILBERG)

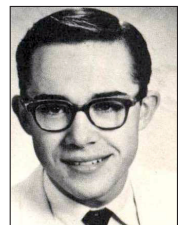

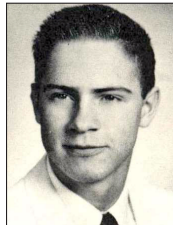

INVOLVES GARY BUNNELL)

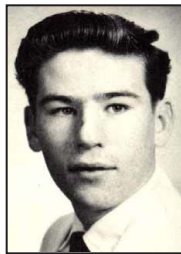

She was informed by the doctors in the spring of 2012, her senior year, that the cancer had come back again and there was nothing they could do this time. The last few months of her life it was tough for her to go to school but she pushed on and graduated. One of the students who said a few words about Emily when she was honored related that there were times when she would not want to come to class and was feeling sorry for herself but then she would look over at Emily and how excited she was to come to school, and her attitude would quickly change. The love and kindness of these high school students was a wonderful blessing to Emily. The acapella choir which she was a part of, sang a very special number at her funeral. As I sat listening to these youth my heart was overflowing with love and appreciation for the privilege of graduating and teaching at Orem High and above all for the outstanding young people that have graduated from this school.

I have been to Scotland two times. . .that is where my family comes from. My clan joined with the McDon-

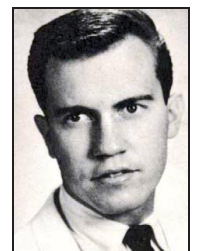

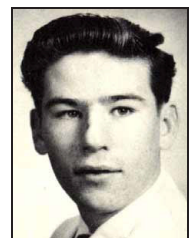

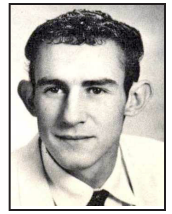
FROM GRENN CLARK (STORY INVOLVES GERT AND LISBETH JENSEN)

FROM PEGGY PACE (STORY INVOLVES JOAN LISCHAK AND SHERRY LOUDER)



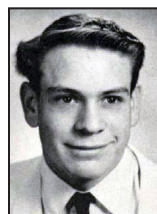

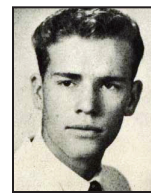

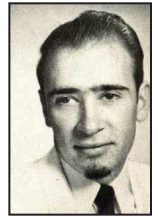


FROM DENNIS HARRISON (STORY INVOLVES

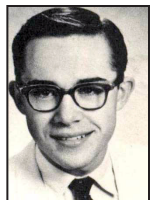
it was Alene. We had a nice visit. We decided to come together to the reunion.
